[Gale](#) - General and useful for most subjects at Swindon College. It contains links to:

[MEDLINE](#) - Life sciences and bio-medical information. Includes journal articles on medicine, nursing, pharmacy, dentistry, veterinary medicine and health care.

[SportDiscus](#) - Includes sports and sports medicine journals. Topics include: bio-mechanics, drugs, exercise, kinesiology, movement science, nutrition, occupational health and therapy, physical fitness, physical therapy, rehabilitation, sports and exercise psychology, coaching and education.

[GreenFILE](#) - Covers all aspects of human impact to the environment. It's a collection of scholarly, government and general interest titles include content on: global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling and more.

[JSTOR](#) - Journal archive for Arts, Humanities, Science and Social Science.

[E-Books for FE](#) - A collection of free e-books for further education colleges through Jisc collections. Staff and Students can access unlimited number of e-books an unlimited number of times anywhere. They cover a wide range of subjects; from Business to Psychology, Construction to Engineering, Sport to Health and Social Care.

The collection also includes GCSE English and Maths textbooks and workbooks – helping support the requirement for Students to re-sit these subjects if they haven't achieved a Grade 4.
